## “To become a facilitator in the IP learning center”

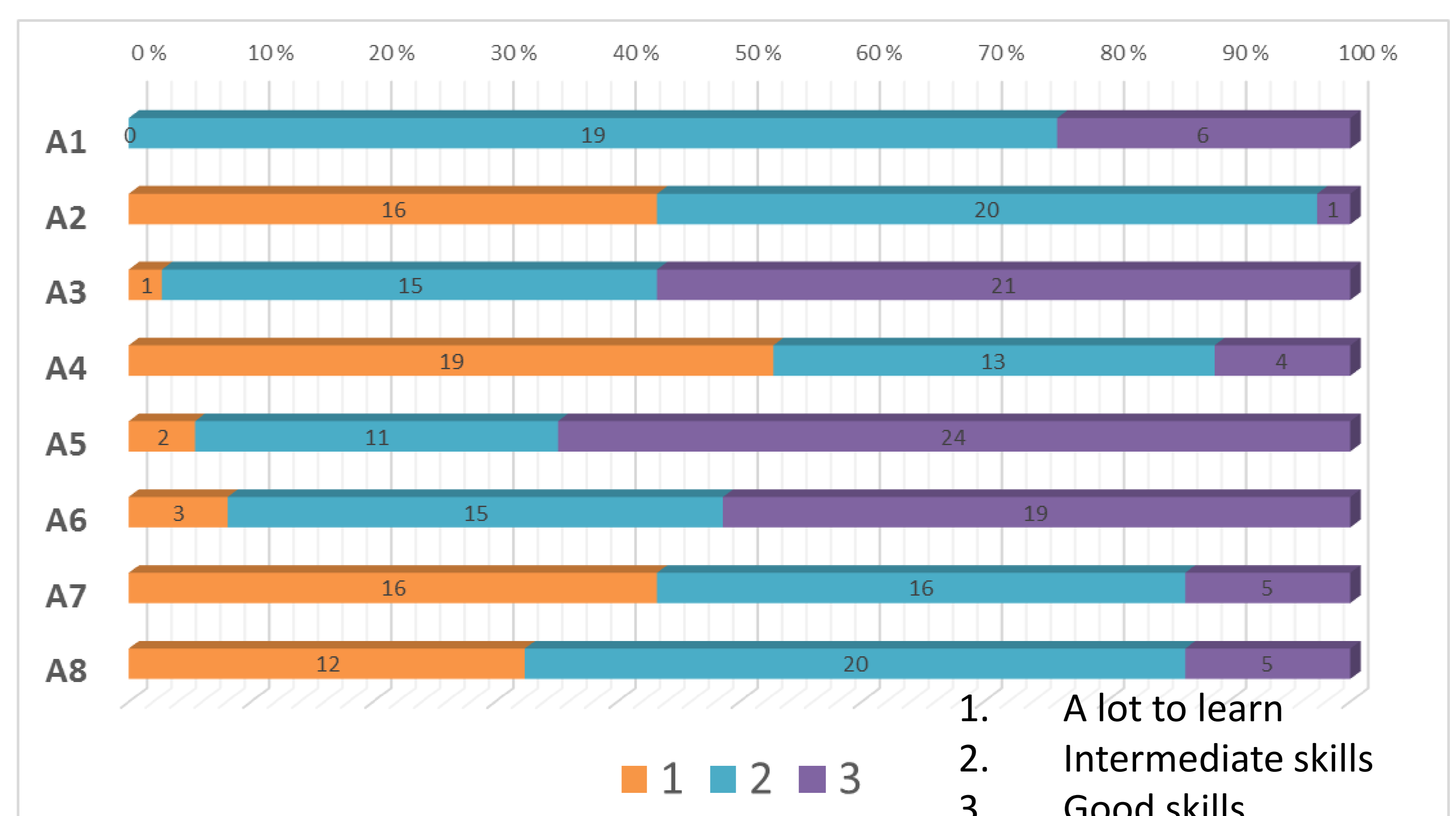
The aims of the training programme for teachers and facilitators were to increase skills to facilitate interprofessional students groups and to innovate a pedagogical model for the IP learning center.

2. Analyze all risks and resources when making the care plan together with the team
3. Make good questions and notice all messages of the patient

6. Work in an IP team
7. Manage time, utilize all strengths and knowledge
8. Priorize
